### Innovation and Sustainability Focus of Second in Series of Governor's Manufacturing Workshops

*Thursday, June 9 Workshop Will Show State's Manufacturers How to Take the Next Step*

The second session of the Governor's Manufacturing Leadership Series workshop will be held on Thursday, June 9 from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Red Blazer Restaurant on 72 Manchester Street in Concord.

Organized by Governor John Lynch, three separate day long workshops designed to address the current needs of the state's manufacturers are being hosted by the New Hampshire Manufacturing Extension Partnership (NH MEP) in coordination with the NH Division of Economic Development. The goal of the workshops is to empower local manufacturers with techniques to overcome challenges and seize the opportunities presented by global markets.

The June 9 workshop focuses on achieving sustainability in a competitive manufacturing market, and embracing technological and organizational changes and advances for New Hampshire manufacturers. Presenters include Dr. Bob Hosford, a nationally recognized expert in organizational development and Zenagui Brahim, director of operations of the NH MEP who will present a new approach in assisting New Hampshire small and medium-sized manufacturers implement innovative and affordable manufacturing methodologies and techniques.
