LE104 is an accelerated learning workshop that conveys the benefits of using Lean methods to achieve breakthrough business performance throughout the entire supply chain.

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

Participants are empowered with an understanding of Lean Supply Chain Management concepts through a series of interactive presentations and team activities. The concepts are then applied in a live simulation that models a realistic supply chain. The hands-on format delivers a number of key "ah ha!" insights that are difficult to acquire through traditional learning methods. Participants work together to build and deliver products via their roles in the simulation. The initial "business as usual" scenario includes high inventory levels, long lead times, inaccurate forecasts, and win/ lose gaming throughout the supply chain.

Participants are challenged to improve the scenario by using Lean supply chain methods. A financial business case is presented that rationalizes and drives collaborative improvement with suppliers and customers to achieve sustainable benefits for all partners. Data that is collected during and after each simulation round is entered into a scoreboard application which graphically displays all of the operational and financial performance results. Through a progression of simulation rounds, participants achieve order of magnitude improvements to the scenario:

- Reduced total lead time
- Increased throughput
- Improved on-time delivery
- Reduced variation

- Improved product quality
- Reduced operational expenses
- Increased productivity
- Increased available capacity
